- Sally Rogers** (1:00-1:30, Nature Center): Sally is a marvelous songwriter and an award-winning singer of traditional and contemporary songs.
- Steve Cormier** (3:30-4:00, Retreat Center): A former working cowboy, Steve brings cowhands, factory workers, and lots of other folks to life in song.
